AWARDS

This paper is written to describe how the Awards will be done and who is responsible for what.

There are basically four (4) types of Awards that are normally presented annually at the District Conference: Rotary International Awards; District Governor's Discretionary Awards; District Committee Awards; and Club Awards.

The Awards program is broken into two (2) basic segments:

A – Award Selection process:

1 – Award Selection process for RI Awards and District Governor's Discretionary Awards – This area is managed by the District Awards Committee. It includes the following:

- a – Defining the Basic premise/purpose of the award
- b – Selection criteria
- c – Recommendations of awardees to the Governor
- d – Write-ups as required as to winner, etc.
- e – Monitoring of and compliance with various due dates

2 – Award Selection process for District Committee Awards – This area is managed by the various District Committees with oversight for schedule compliance by the District Awards Committee. It includes the following:

- a – Defining the Basic premise/purpose of the award
- b – Selection criteria
- c – Selection of winner
- d – Write-ups as required as to winner, etc.
- e – Compliance with various schedule dates established by the District Awards Committee

3 – Award Selection process for Club Sponsored Awards – This area is managed by the various Clubs that sponsor Awards with oversight for schedule compliance by the District Awards Committee. It includes the following:

- a – Defining the Basic premise/purpose of the award
- b – Selection criteria
- c – Selection of winner
- d – Write-ups as required as to winner, etc.
- e – Compliance with various schedule dates established by the District Awards Committee

B – Award Presentation Process:

The Award Presentation Process for all Awards is managed by the Awards Sub-Committee of the District Conference Committee. It includes the following:

1 - Receiving, from the various Selection entities, the required write-ups on the schedule dates. Note: Write-ups not received by the specified date may cause the award not to be presented at the District Conference.

2 – Publishing or causing to be published the Awards Booklet

3 – Preparing the Award Presentation material (normally a power point presentation)

4 – Orchestrating the Awards Presentation at the District Conference as specified by the District Conference Committee.
